Following the message from the Director of the Institute, Professor Dario Braga, we are now able to send you some further information on your visiting professorship.

For all local arrangements, including those concerning custom and residence permits if required, your local organizer will be the proponent of your visit, Professor Armando Bazzani.

Your Fellowship will cover the following period:

## **One month** from 1 May to 31 May 2017

If you accept the Fellowship, as we sincerely hope, you will be asked to deliver a *general lecture* about the subject matter of your studies suitable to a multidisciplinary audience to the fellows of the Institute of Advanced Studies and to the students of the Collegio Superiore (<u>www.collegio.unibo.it</u>). Interdisciplinary contributions are very welcome according to the spirit of the Institute.

The most important points of your Fellowship are below summarized:

(i) **accommodation** in an apartment suitable for a maximum of two people located in Via De Rolandis 3, in the historical centre of Bologna, close to the Institute of Advanced Studies.

(ii) a **Fellows Room** for studying and reading with free wireless Internet, a multifunction printer and several computers is available for all our Visiting Fellows. It is close to the Rectorate and totally dedicated to our Fellows' use although visiting professors are expected to have their main working space at the hosting Department.

(iii) ISA provides Fellows with **insurance** against accidents and for third public-liability (RCT), covering the use of all the facilities of the University of Bologna.
